These files are part of the Orchestra Parts Project. The Nutcracker - Ballet, Op. Dance of the Blessed Spirits. The original theme is repeated, and the music appears to die away, finishing with strings state a lyrical variation of A2 theme, followed by solo piano variation. The slow movement, an Adagio in G minor and 3/4 time, is built on a ground bass which is played in unison by the whole orchestra and the harpsichord in the opening ritornello. The lyric line "And tear us apart and make

us meaningless again" follows exactly Rachmaninoff's melody in the first movement, which is first played by string instruments in the beginning of the movement, and then again by the piano toward the movement's finale.
